



Escuela de Liderazgo Cristiano, Pharr TX – Pastor Noe Reyes, Director

Escuela de Liderazgo Cristiano (ELC) in Pharr, TX is an Artios satellite campus.

ELC courses consist of ten weeks of instruction during which students participate in weekly sessions. Courses include both lecture and discussion and students may be assigned additional reading or written assignments at the discretion of the instructor*.

**Students who wish to earn Artios credit must complete reading and written assignments as outlined in the syllabus for the equivalent Artios course, and earn a [passing grade](#).*

Center Dual Credit:

Students who complete a program through ELC will automatically receive recognition from both the ELC and the [Artios Center for Vibrant Leadership](#) in the form of a graduation certificate and may participate in a formal graduation ceremony in Pharr, TX.

Artios Credit:

Additionally, students may opt to earn Artios Christian College credit for any of the courses (see cross-listed courses [here](#)) taken through ELC. Students who wish to earn Artios credit must have completed reading and written assignments as outlined in the syllabus for the equivalent Artios course, and earned a [passing grade](#). The cost for applying for Artios credit is the [current tuition](#) rate at the time of application. Included in the cost is a \$100 non-refundable application fee. Students not granted credit will receive a refund less the application fee.

Students who wish to earn Artios credit may do so through the following procedure:

1. Before your course begins, notify your ELC instructor of your intention to earn Artios credit.
2. Complete the required assignments and earn a passing grade.
3. Up to one year following the completion of course, login to [myArtios](#)* and apply for Artios credit at <https://my.artioscollege.org/en/forms/credit-for-satellite-campus-course>.

Upon receipt of an application for Artios credit, Artios administration will follow up with ELC instructor to obtain student course materials, certify their eligibility for obtaining credit, and add the course/credit to the student's Artios transcript. Allow 4-6 weeks processing time. Student will receive an email notification when credit application has been processed.

ELC courses are processed as transfer courses without [honor points](#). To receive an Artios certificate or degree, students must formally [enroll in an Artios degree or certificate program](#) and earn 25% of total credits through Artios Christian College. To remain in their Artios program, ELC students must earn credit for at least one class through Artios Christian College per academic year (as per the [student status policy](#)) or indicate their intention to remain in the program by submitting the [active student exception request form](#) at the end each academic year.
