> Exciting news—the Artios Center for Vibrant Leadership turns four years old this spring! It was in 2019 that the dream of an initiative dedicated to grassroots leadership training and development became a reality.









The College and the Center

The Center is an initiative of Artios Christian College. The College is an online liberal arts institution dedicated to equipping leaders for missional engagement at home, school, church, and in their community. The Center for Vibrant Leadership serves as a "come alongside" ministry to leaders within their local contexts through onsite training, coaching, consulting, and the development of helpful print and online resources.

This effort is driven by Artios' core convictions that equipping leaders for a vibrant 21st century church is its best contribution to the work of the kingdom, and that the most effective way in which to cultivate vibrant churches is to equip vibrant leaders.

To that end, Center operations began in earnest with the publication of <u>Vibrant</u> <u>Church</u>, a 250-page volume that fleshes out the Conference's Ten Point Vision in practical ways.

Then, after a launch seminar at the Albuquerque Convention and the kick-off of its first Vibrant Church Event in Los Angeles in early 2020, the global pandemic hit!

What to do when the world stops? For the Artios Center, it was an opportunity to carry out the "come alongside" aspect of its work. Attendees will come away from this 90 minute session with a passion to make the most of the COVID-19 crisis, cutting edge information and practical tools for personal growth, resources include free follow-up coaching opportunities and encouragement and challenge for ministry beyond COVID-19.

SPEAKING, COACHING, AND CONSULTING

Since the inception of the Center, its dean, Whaid Rose, has kept busy with speaking engagements in places such as Trinidad and Tobago, Guyana (South America), and more recently in Marion, Oregon; Petersburg, Michigan; Pharr, Texas; and Lodi, Californiaconducting Vibrant Church events. But nothing has kept him busier than virtual speaking engagements, ranging from local church events to conventions in the United Kingdom, Canada, Jamaica, and a host of other locations! The Center has also served as a coaching and consulting resource for individual leaders, church boards, and national conferences, a major example being a ten-month group coaching with the leadership of the British Conference, known as The UK Leadership Coaching initiative. These sessions revolved around character formation and the development of fresh vision for the future of the church in the UK. It was quite a success!

PROTECTING YOUR MINISTRY

The Center also featured a six-part webinar series on how to guard against the pitfalls of sexual abuse and harassment, conducted in English and Spanish in early 2021. These presentations are also logged at the <u>Center</u> <u>website.</u>



LEADING THE WAY

In the weeks and months that followed, the Center hosted some half a dozen such events, including one on mental health as unprecedented levels of stress and grief pushed people beyond their limits. Video recordings of these webinars are logged at the <u>Center website</u>, available for viewing as free ministry resources.

Looking Ahead

Exciting developments are on the horizon for the Center in 2023, including the launch of a leadership podcast, the publication of several books and print resources, the translation of Vibrant Church into Spanish, the creation of the Calvin Burrell Digital Library, relevant webinars, and more.

In addition, the Center also remains ready to come alongside you and your local church with leadership training, individual and group coaching, and consulting. These services may be provided virtually, and topics may vary from matters germane to a particular local context to core leadership issues. The end goal is helping you lead with clarity, fresh vision, and vibrancy.

Summer Seminars

A major achievement of the Center is its Summer Seminars conducted in 2021 (Where Do We Go From Here?) and 2022 (<u>Gospel Centered Preaching</u>), to equip leaders through instruction and encouragement, and provide opportunities for continuing education hours for license renewal.
