## ARTIOS STATS


I love stats! Here's some of ours.

**SINCE LAST CONVENTION**, over 150 students have registered for close to 600 classes and earned more than 2000 credits! 25 have completed an academic program and will be recognized at graduation commencement this Saturday. Nearly 300 have participated in an Artios Center for Vibrant Leadership webinar, and dozens have audited a satellite campus course.

**IN TOTAL** (since 2009), 660 students have registered for over 4700 classes, earning a whopping 15,888 credits! 220 have completed their program. Of these 220 graduates, 10 are from outside of US/Canada, 46 are current active licensed ministers (comprising 65% of the active licensed ministers), 42 are women, and 112 have taken their classes in Spanish.

## NEW DEVELOPMENTS

### HOUSTON SATELLITE CAMPUS

Artios is excited to be piloting an in-person hybrid classroom in Houston, TX. This program is planned to run eight courses over two-year cycles in English and Spanish. Students who successfully complete this sequence will earn the requirements for a Certificate of Leadership Studies from Artios. This program expands our instructional methodology with a focus on in-person interactions, but otherwise uses the same course outline and syllabus for each course as the standard online versions of each class.

### RE-RECORDING LECTURES

We are in the middle of recording new lectures for all our classes. Many of these lectures were recorded a while ago and the recording quality is sometimes not very good. We have developed a production process for these lectures, and we are pleased with the resulting quality. We have also incorporated visuals and teaching aids into the videos in editing.

This process will take about two years but should improve our courses as the video lectures provide an important audio and visual element to each class.

### INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

Artios has received interest from international students since the beginning. Some of our graduates hail from overseas. However, the cost of school for international students, even online, is particularly high. With this in mind, we have set a path for a CG7 International Scholarship to help with the cost. To qualify, students must have a proven track record of taking classes with Artios, among other things, and then must apply to receive it. Consider donating to the Artios "Scholarship Fund", as this may be the only way for some students in our sister conferences to get this kind of training.

Gustavo has taught courses in all departments and levels of the Artios curriculum. He has instructed the following courses:


- BIS 101 History and Literature of the Old Testament




